

STORY CARDS TO SEND

Print this 3 times. Cut the large outer frame for each story card. Fold on the inside lines to create a double sided card with 6 frames for you to write or draw each part of your story. Before starting, think of a simple story that can be told in three parts.

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Card 1 - Beginning: Introduce characters and setting. Draw your main character(s) where the story starts, like a rabbit in a forest. Write a few sentences to begin your story.

Card 2 - Middle: Add a twist. Illustrate the main event. For instance, Ruby the rabbit discovers a mysterious map. Continue your story, e.g., "Ruby found a map showing a hidden forest treasure!"

Card 3 - Conclusion: Resolve the story. Show your character(s) solving the problem. Maybe Ruby finds a treasure of delicious carrots. Conclude your story.

Sending Your Cards: Mail them in sequence, possibly a week apart or as a countdown to a special event. Mark each card as "Card 1 of 3", "Card 2 of 3", "Card 3 of 3" to indicate the series.
